Job description:

The Director of Fundraising shall:

- 1.) Seek sources of revenue for underwater hockey beyond the usual sources of Underwater Society of America (USOA) dues and tournament fees.
- 2.) Write grants seeking funding for underwater hockey from all possible sources including non-profit charitable foundations and/or from the federal, state, and/or local governments.
- 3.) Seek corporate sponsorship for USA Underwater Hockey or for USA National Teams competing in Worlds Championships.
- 4.) Seek support from the USA Olympic organization and/or other national sports federations.
- 5.) In conjunction with the Director of Marketing and Press Relations, the Director of Fundraising will seek opportunities to promote the sport of underwater hockey to those companies and/or non-profit foundations that could provide financial support to the sport of underwater hockey.
- 6.) Report to the USA Underwater Hockey Committee on a regular basis.

Requirements: The person must be a dues paying member of USOA and an active member of the U.S. underwater hockey community.

Compensation will be agreed upon between the successful candidate and the USA Underwater Hockey Committee.
